# Near the Oregon Convention Center 

Many of Portland's favorite destinations and neighborhoods are within 12 minutes of the Oregon Convention Center (OCC) by foot, train (MAX Light Rail or Portland Streetcar) or car.

## BY FOOT

Within a short stroll, you can reach the restaurants and bars and more in Lloyd and the Central Eastside.

## 1. Metropolitan Tavern

0.2 mi • 5 min walk

Take in city views from Hotel Eastlund's rooftop restaurant and bar.

## 2. Ranger Chocolate Co.

$0.2 \mathrm{mi} \cdot 5$ min walk $\cdot 4$ min streetcar
Savor small-batch coffee and craft chocolate in one welcoming space.

## 3. Moda Center

0.4 mi • 9 min walk • 7 min MAX

The home of the NBA's Trail Blazers also hosts a wide variety of concerts and events.

## 4. Canard

$0.5 \mathrm{mi} \cdot 11$ min walk $\cdot 7$ min streetcar
Café by day, Canard becomes a wine bar with great cocktails and food by night.
5. Nong's Khao Man Gai

## 6 mi • 13 min walk • 8 min streetcar

One of Portland's favorites started out selling just one signature dish: khao man gai, a Thai street-food staple that's as simple as it is delicious.

## 6. Pine State Biscuits

. $7 \mathrm{mi} \cdot 15 \mathrm{~min}$ walk
Towering North Carolina-style butter biscuits and creative filling. The Reggie Deluxe is a must-taste.

## BY TRAIN

A quick ride on the Portland Streetcar or MAX Light Rail will take you deeper into the Central Eastside, or across the river to the attractions and shops of Old Town Chinatown and Downtown.

## 7. Wayfinder Beer

$0.6 \mathrm{mi} \cdot 6 \mathrm{~min}$ streetcar • 11 min walk
Enjoy some fresh air, fries and a pint of IPA on the massive outdoor patio.

## 8. Doug Fir Lounge

0.6 mi • 9 min streetcar $\cdot 12$ min walk

The Doug Fir is a must-see for lovers of live indie music and log cabin décor.

## 9. Lan Su Chinese Garden

1 mi • 11 min $M A X \cdot 18$ min walk
This authentically built Ming dynasty-style garden offers a tranquil urban escape.

## 10. VooDoo Doughnut

1.2 mi • 13 min $M A X$ - 18 min walk

Open 24 hours a day, seven days a week for doughnut worshippers.
11. Portland Saturday Market
1.3 mi • 12 min $M A X \cdot 18$ min walk

Peruse local arts at this riverside market every Saturday and Sunday, March-Dec. 24.

## 12. Pine Street Market

1.3 mi • 12 min $M A X \cdot 18$ min walk

This chef-driven food hall offers diverse dining options in historic Old Town.


## BY CAR

Hail a ride-share or taxi, and you can reach the Pearl District, Division/Clinton and many other Northwest, North, Northeast and Southeast
Portland neighborhoods.

## 13. Ox Restaurant

1.1 mi • 7 min car $\cdot 15$ min streetcar This Argentinean-inspired steakhouse is a 2017 James Beard Award winner.

## 14. Powell's City of Books

1.2 mi • 5 min car • 25 min walk

The world's largest new and used bookstore occupies an entire city block.

## 15. Afuri Izakaya - SE

1.3 mi - 6 min car - 11 min streetcar Portland holds the honor of being home to the first Afuri outside of Japan.

## 16.OMSI

$1.5 \mathrm{mi} \cdot 6$ min car $\cdot 14$ min streetcar The Oregon Museum of Science and Industry's five enormous halls bring science to life.

## 17. Portland Art Museum

1.6 mi • 6 min car • 14 min MAX

Discover sculpture, Native arts and special exhibits at the Northwest's oldest museum.

## 18. Cartopia

1.6 mi - 7 min car - 18 min streetcar The Central Eastside's food carts is one of Portland's longest-running pods and is open late into the night.
19. Ava Gene's

3 mi • 11 min car
Seasonal produce is the star at Joshua McFadden's Romaninspired restaurant.
